A Close of Day service will be celebrated at 5.30pm. All welcome.

Following a midday finish of the Australian National Conference held at the Michael Centre, Warranwood, all participants are invited to return to the Chapel in Hawthorn for afternoon tea, to peruse the Art Exhibition, and participate in a Close of Day Service. Please join us if you can.

Note: Please use a separate form for each exhibit and make 3 copies. Attach one copy to your entry when it is delivered. Email or post a copy to the Coordinator and addresses above and a copy for yourself.

\$10 entry fee per art work/wall hanging

\$5 entry fee per artisanal piece ie. metal work, ceramics etc (Multiple pieces that fit into a 20cm x 20cm area are counted as one piece - so one entry fee).

Categories: This exhibition offers the opportunity for a variety of artistic mediums - wall hung, metal work, wood work, ceramics etc. Smaller pieces will be displayed in a display cabinet and on one table space.

Number of Entries: There is a limit of 1 x large wall hung piece or 2 artisan pieces per person.

All wall-hung work:

- must have secure fixtures for hanging. It is preferred that all pieces are framed. We will not be able to receive your work if it does not have secure fixtures for hanging.
- hung work must be no larger than 100 cm x 80 cm.
- entries will be received on a 'first come' basis. There is limited gallery space and we apologise if we are unable to accept your entry due to limited space.

 in the event that we receive a low number of entries please indicate on your entry form if you would like to be contacted with the potential to include another piece.

Whilst every care will be taken with your work The Christian Community takes no responsibility for theft, loss of work or damage whatsoever. If you are concerned about this, we advise you to take out your own insurance prior to the start of the exhibition.

Volunteering: We will require a list of volunteers to host the gallery space during exhibition opening times of Wednesday's 1 - 4, Saturday's 10 - 4, Sunday's 12 - 5. Please indicate on the entry form if you are willing to volunteer to host the gallery space. If so, we will contact you to create the roster closer to the time.
