OBERUFERER MEDIEVAL CHRISTIAN MYSTERY PLAYS - IRIS CURTEIS

The plays now known as the Oberuferer Christmas Plays stem from ancient folklore performed during festive seasons in the Middle Ages. Those who initially cultivated these plays were probably of Alemannic origin. The three Plays: Paradis Play, Christ Birth Play, Three Kings Play, form a triptych. Rudolf Steiner was introduced to them by his teacher and friend, Karl Julius Schröer, who encountered them on his travels. Schröer, a scholar in folklore, was so impressed, he approached those who still carried this tradition and taught others and asked them to recall what their teachers or those who were fellow players still held in their memories. What they told him was something that is truly centuries-old, sacred property. This folklore has been preserved through word of mouth until the 1850s and, through Rudolf Steiner, enthusiastically incorporated into Anthroposophical 'cultural tradition'.
