The Workshop Fund

The Workshop Fund has been set up by a generous donor with the specific purpose of supporting individuals or small groups to run or attend workshops in Australia, in all fields of Anthroposophy. It is managed by the Management Group of the Anthroposophical Society in Australia.

Eligibility:

- 1. Young people are encouraged to apply, but also
- 2. Any individuals for whom the support means they are able to attend workshop.
- 3. Workshop holders may apply if they have only a small number of participants and need help to make their workshop financially viable.

Conditions:

- 1. The fund is not intended for organisations and businesses.
- 2. It is in the spirit of this fund to support one-off workshops rather than ongoing programs.
- 3. In some cases (e.g. with repeat applications), some restriction may apply, and sometimes the answer may be No.
- 4. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year, but need to be submitted before the 1st of the month to be tabled on the agenda of the ASinA Management Group at their next monthly meeting.
- 5. All applications must be made IN ADVANCE of the relevant workshop.
- 6. The Management Group's decision is binding.
