## PROGRAMME

Day one: TRUTH-TELLING AND DEEP LISTENING First People and new-Australians will find a respectful space for grief and sorrow, space to acknowledge the truth that this loss and anguish did not end with the end of a massacre, but continues to this day. A space in which nonindigenous people can and will find a place for their sorrow and shame, especially if their families participated in atrocities and find a way to grieve.

Day two: RECOGNISING THE ON-GOING EFFECTS The massacres lead to stolen country, loss of connection, culture, language, sacred sites and stolen children. The environmental destruction of this continent is a direct consequence of the rightful custodians no longer being able to care for country, the Mother of all life, in the right way. The first day of the first massacre was the first day of the destruction of this continent.

## Day three: RESTORATIVE JUSTICE = RESTORING CUSTODIANSHIP

We will focus on restorative justice and how, together, we can create lasting change. Restorative justice includes selfdetermination and autonomy and economic justice for the First People of this country. It addresses education, health, suicide prevention (especially in consideration of young) in ways appropriate to culture/s. This justice is built on restoring custodianship of country and restoring powers of decision-making to the rightful custodians.
